WHAT IS A PECC?

A prehospital pediatric emergency care coordinator (PECC) is an individual, or team of individuals, responsible for coordinating pediatric specific activities for an EMS agency. PECCs are the pediatric champions for their organization.

WHO CAN BE A PECC?

Anyone with a passion for ensuring high quality pediatric emergency care can be a PECC. This could be an EMT, paramedic, RN, PA, MD, etc.

Promote pediatric-specific education at their agency



Ensure availability of pediatric-specific equipment



Participate in pediatric QI initiatives



Promote family-centered care
